

# **BIG CREEK - Vehicle Minimum Safety Requirements**



- **4WD-working- 4WDs only - NO 'Side by Sides', Rails, 2WD Buggies, etc.**
- **Adequate Brakes including parking brake**
- **2 adequate "Recovery Points"- 1 front & 1 rear**
- **Reverse**
- **4 point Roll Bar with open or soft top vehicles**
- **Battery (s) properly held down – No Bungees**
- **Seat Belt (s) –For all passengers and driver**
- **Tires have adequate tread**
- **No leaks!**
- **No Full Size 4WD vehicles allowed on BIG CREEK trails. Example: F-150, 1500, Ram or similar Full Size 4WDs**
- **Low Range**
- **Fire Extinguisher**
- **Full Size Spare Tire**
- **First Aid Kit**
- **Jack Capable of lifting the vehicle and tools to change the tire**
- **3" minimum wide strap with looped ends -8' to 20' length**

**\*Un-licensed vehicles are allowed at BIG CREEK, however; they will need to be legally towed to riding area parking lots. Vehicles subject to inspection at any time and deemed un-worthy. Off-road/BIG CREEK worthiness is a judgement call made by a BIG CREEK representative.**
