Riding Rules and Regulations

“NNS” – No Needless Spinning!

- Safety First!
- No Alcohol on trails!
- Seat Belts must be worn always by all passengers and driver.
- Parking Brake must be used - Always. Put vehicle in Park or First gear every time.
- Drivers are responsible for their passenger. Drivers are: First In vehicle and Last Out!
- Vehicles may be inspected at any time and deemed unsafe for use by a Big Creek representative.
- An experienced Marshall must be in control during all winching/recovery operations.
- Drivers give verbal warnings when others are nearby. Example: “Moving” “Backing”
- Slow as possible – using micro-momentum is necessary
- Pack it In – Pack it Out; Please no Littering
- Camp Fires must be within Rock Fire Rings only! Burning of only “dead and down” trees.
- No OHV traveling within yellow taped off areas or Fenced off areas
- Must have current Driver’s License to operate licensed vehicle.
- Parents/Guardians must supervise their children/minors.
- No Horse Play! Slow Down!
- No Vulgar Language!
- Violators will be asked to leave or escorted out. 3 Strikes you’re Out!
If violation is severe enough, violator will be escorted out with one strike.
- ATV/UTV/Dirt Bikes are not allowed. Special permission
Passes “may” be available upon request.
- No Night Rides! Clubs responsible for leading rides during daylight hours only!
- No Full Size 4WD vehicles allowed. Example: F-150, 1500, Ram or similar Full Size 4WDs.
- I understand that I must enter and exit Center Methodist Church Road from Coggins Mine Road. Thank you for keeping our neighbors happy!
- ***Both Waiver and Rules/Regulation must be signed! ***
